

History of IHSAA Boys Swimming Championships

From 1928 thru 1930 the boys' state finals were not sponsored by the IHSAA and were by invitation only. Columbus High School hosted these three meets won by Indianapolis Shortridge, Whiting, East Chicago Washington respectively.

The Decade is: In 1931 the first annual IHSAA sponsored Boys Swimming and Diving State Championship was held at Columbus High School (60 ft. pool) with 10 teams participating and South Bend Central claiming the team title. The events contested in the first championship included the 160 yard relay, 40 yard freestyle, 100 yard backstroke, 220 yard freestyle, 100 yard breaststroke, and the 120 yard medley relay (40 yd. each of backstroke, breaststroke and freestyle). Fancy diving was also an event, consisting of a running front, standing back, running front jack knife and a standing back jack knife. The 1932 meet was held at Butler University (75 ft. pool) with 11 teams competing. The 1933 meet was held at the Whiting Community Center (60 ft. pool). In 1934 and 1935 Butler was once again the site. The 1936 and 1937 state meets weren't even held in Indiana. The IHSAA allowed Hammond High School to host the meet which was then moved to Thornton Fractional High School in Calumet City, Illinois due to a "better pool facility." (60 ft. pool) In 1938, the state meet, again was hosted by Hammond High School at the brand new Hammond Civic Center (75 ft. pool). The 1939, the state meet was held at South Bend Central (60 ft. pool).

The Decade is: The 1940 thru 1943 meets were held at Purdue University (75 ft. pool). From 1944 to 1950 there were **NO State Championships because of World War II.**

The Decade is: From 1951 thru 1962, Purdue University again was the site with a record 22 teams participating. In 1951 the 220 yard freestyle was changed to the 200 yard freestyle. The 150 yard individual medley was added as an event in 1954 and was changed to a 200 yard individual medley event by adding the butterfly leg to the swimming event in 1956. The 100 yard butterfly-breaststroke was changed to the 100 yard breaststroke and a separate 100 yard butterfly event was added in 1957. In the spring of 1958, the boys meet now extended over two day period with the meet taking on a whole new look. In 1959 the 400 yard freestyle event was added to the meet becoming the longest event to date.

The Decade is: In 1961, for the first time, standards of performance were established by the IHSAA. First place finishers in the sectional and any swimmer who bettered the set standards would advance to the state meet. In 1963 the IHSAA sponsored three boys' sectionals at Columbus HS, Culver Military Academy and South Bend Washington for 31 teams. The State Meet was held in the new Royer Pool on the campus of Indiana University, Bloomington. Indiana's Royer Pool remained the site through 1969 with seven sectionals being contested for 71 schools in that year. In 1966, the 200 yard freestyle relay was changed to the 400 yard freestyle relay (100 yards each of freestyle).

The Decade is: In 1970, 84 teams participated in eight sectionals and the State meet moved to the new pool at Ball State University, Muncie. One meter diving went from a 10 dive program to an 11 dive program in 1970. In 1974, the only distance event became longer making it a 500 yard freestyle event.

In the spring of 1975, *the first annual Girls Swimming and Diving State Championships* were held at Warren Central High School. It was no longer a G.A.A. sport (Girls Athletic Association). Seventy-four teams participated in this first Girls State Meet. The Girls State Championships then moved to Ball State University the next year.

In 1978 due to the energy crisis the boys meet was moved to Culver Military Academy. Through this time the sport of IHSAA swimming grew immensely, both state swim finals were held at Ball State University through 1982. The finals that year had 168 boys' teams participating in 16 sectionals.

The Decade is: In 1982 State Swim Championships were moved to its current location, The Indiana University Natatorium on the IUPUI campus in Indianapolis. The IUPUI Natatorium is known as the "fastest pool in the world." Beginning in 1983 the sectional winners, those achieving the time standards, and the swimmers with the next fastest sectional times was used to fill 32 positions to advance to the state meet. This is still the standard today.

The Decade is: After a 25 year absence 1966-1990 the 200 yard freestyle relay was brought back for the 1990-1991 season making a total of three relays. Also, at that time an individual could participate in two relays and two individual events. In 1995 the state tournament saw the addition of diving regionals to the tournament series. There became 4 regional sites and at each site the top eight divers advanced to the State Finals that Saturday making thirty two divers at State like the swimming events. The 23rd annual Girls State Championships were held in February 1997 **the girls season moved from a fall to a winter sport.** Only 2 weeks separated them.

The Decade is: In its 25th year of existence, the IU Natatorium on the IUPUI campus hosted the 2007 Girls and Boys State Championships. There were 334 boys representing 91 schools. It was at this year's championships that several Indiana High School Swimming and Diving Hall of Fame inaugural inductees were introduced and so the history of our sport continues.

In 2009, it was Chesterton's day from the get-go winning back to back State Championships. It was "pure quality" not depth this year for Chesterton. North Central HS, Munster HS, and Carmel HS made history by finishing the team championship with a three way tie for second place. William Bass and Kyle Whitaker from Chesterton and Nathan Kinney from Hamilton Southeastern were double winners. Casey Johnson became the first Indian Creek HS State Champ in diving. Kyle Whitaker swam a national record 1:45.25 winning his 200 individual medley event.

In 2010, Chesterton's Kyle Whitaker won the Mental Attitude Award, breaking his own National High School record in the 200 individual medley and adding a state record in the 500yd freestyle. Whitaker became the first swimmer in Indiana history for

the boys to win eight individual State championships. He also was part of four State championship relay teams, tying the record for overall titles set by Carmel's Jason Lancaster from 1991 to 1994.

In 2011 Carmel wins two in a row totaling 13 and Bloomington South finishes runner-up. Harrison Wagner was named the Mental Attitude Award winner, won the 50 & 100 freestyle events, and added a State record in the 50yd freestyle.

The 2012 State Meet was a repeat of last year's final only closer. The margin of victory between Carmel and Bloomington South was 1 1/2 points. It came down to the last event making it the 3rd closest finish in the history of Boys swimming. Bloomington South won all three relays even though they did finish runner-up in the meet. The remaining nine individual events were first time medal winners and from nine different schools. There were no meet records set.

In 2013 Chesterton wins in high style. Two sets of twins helped Chesterton (Aaron & Ethan Whitaker) win the championship with North Central (Theodore & Joseph Steinkamp) finishing runner-up. Aaron Whitaker set two individual state records in the 100 butterfly & backstroke and with his twin they set another state record in the 400 freestyle relay. Team member, Blake Pieroni won two individual and two relay events setting a new state record in the 100 free and 400 free relay. The North Central twins were on the winning 200 free relay. Joshua Arndt, LaPorte is a two time state diving champ. The remaining event winners, Matt Irwin, Austin Flager, Trevor Carroll are now double winners in the top 20.

In 2014, Chesterton dominates and repeats again. Avon High School finishes 2nd for the first time in the schools' history. Aaron Whitaker and Blake Pieroni of Chesterton won their two individual events and were members of two winning relays. These two combined for five new State Meet records.

In 2015, Carmel won just one event but captured the title with its team depth. Zionsville finishes 2nd for the first time in the schools' history. Ian Finnerty of Bloomington South and Kyle DeCoursey of Zionsville both set one new state record apiece while winning two individual titles. Six teams: Avon, Brownsburg, Columbus North, Fort Wayne Snider, Munster, and Homestead won the remaining events spreading the bounty of wins across the State. Joe Young of Hamilton Southeastern finished 2nd in his two events and was named the Mental Attitude Award winner.

An additional note to this year's format was a new method of scoring diving.

In 2016, The 79th State Championship meet came down to a one point difference. The last time this occurred was 27 years ago. Carmel and Zionsville finished one and two just like the year before. Chandler Bray of Avon set a State and National record in the 100 yds breaststroke, received the Mental Attitude Award, and was on the State record setting 200 yds. freestyle relay. This record had lasted an amazing 22 years. Zionsville's Jack Franzman was a double winner in his events. Kevin Frebel, Homestead repeated as the State diving champ. Carmel had back to back event winners in the 200 yds freestyle and 200 yds. individual medley. Carroll (Fort Wayne) captured a relay and individual win and Northridge captured an individual win to complete the meet.

In 2017, the 80th State Championship had for the third year in a row, Carmel winning the meet and Zionsville finishing second. Carmel's total points was a mere 10 points off the state record for points scored. There was a 130 point margin over Zionsville. However, a measure of Zionsville's strength was that it had nine top-three finishes to Carmel's ten. The theme for this year's meet was records, both state and national. There were four state records and one national record set in the preliminaries. Drew Kibler of Carmel set a state and national record in the 200 Freestyle and a state record in the 100 Freestyle. Zionsville's Jack Franzman set a state record in the 50 Freestyle (19.85) to become the first in the state to break 20 seconds. Carmel's 200 Freestyle relay team of Couchon, Vaughn, Kopp, and Batista also set a new state record. In the finals, there were three state records and one national record set. Zionsville's 200 Medley Relay team of Harmon, Brown, Schuler, and Franzman set a state and national record. Carmel's Drew Kibler broke his 100 Freestyle record he set in the preliminaries. Carmel's 200 Freestyle relay team (Couchon, Vaughn, Batista, and Kibler) broke the record set in the preliminaries. Kibler of Carmel was a four event winner (200 & 100 Free, 200 & 400 Free Relay). Spencer Lehman of Northridge (200 IM & 500 Free) and Franzman of Zionsville (50 Free & 200 Med Relay) were both double event winners. Carmel's Wyatt Davis won the 100 Backstroke to become the first freshman to win that event since 1985 and only the second freshman to ever win that event. He was also the first swimmer from Carmel to win that event. Isaac Khamis from Richmond held on to win diving by a mere .55 of a point. Zionsville's Tyler Harmon was named the Mental Attitude Award winner. Tyler swam the backstroke leg of Zionsville's winning 200 Med Relay. He also finished third in the 200 free, runner-up in the 100 back, and was a member of the runner-up 400 free relay team.

In 2018, Carmel won their fourth consecutive state title, setting two state meet records, one National record and set a record for the most team points scored and won (nine of eleven) swimming events. Carmel more than doubled the team score of runnerup Franklin Community. This was Franklin Community's first ever second place team finish at State and their Coach Zachary DeWitt was named Coach of the Year. Carmel's Coach Chris Plumb tied Jon Jepsen for the most State Team Championships by any boys coach. Isaac Khamis, Richmond won his second State title in diving and took home the Herman Keller Mental Attitude Award.

In 2019, Carmel won a fifth successive state championship with Franklin Community as runner-ups again in team scores. Jacob Mitchell and Wyatt Davis of Carmel won their two individual races contributing four state titles and they were members of the Carmel relay teams. The team won all three relays and it was Carmel setting three new State records. Jacob Mitchell, 500 Freestyle and Wyatt Davis, 100 Backstroke and they were both on the record setting 400 Free Relay. Jacob Destrampe, Franklin Community won gold in his two events the 50 and 100 Free and he was on two of their runnerup relay teams. He finished his high school career by winning the Herman Keller Mental Attitude Award.

In 2020, Carmel won a sixth successive state championship with Munster as the runnerups. Jacob Mitchell (200 & 500 free) and Wyatt Davis (IM & back) won their two individual races and contributed to the victory on two relay championships (Medley & 400). They set a total of five IHSAA records (Medley Relay, 200IM, 500 free, 100 back, 400 free relay) and two of them were National HS Public Records (medley relay & 500 free). Braden Rollins of Boonville won the 50 & 100 free. Tristan

DeWitt of Carroll FW won the fly making it two in a row. Penn HS won the 200 free relay. Sam Bennett of Delta won diving and Alders of Chesterton won the breaststroke.

In 2021, The state finals were contested without spectators for the first time due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The state meet was won once again by Carmel capturing three state titles. Zionsville's Will Modglin won titles in the 200 IM and 100 Back. The other two-time winner was Brady Samuels of Delta in the 50 Free & 100 Fly. Completing three wins for Delta HS was Samuel Bennett in Diving making it two wins in a row for him as well as this year MA winner. Penn HS was a repeat winner in the 200 Free Relay just .08 seconds away from the state record. Seniors Keegan Streett of Hamilton Southeastern and Ethan Martin of Center Grove finished their careers taking first in the 200 Free and 100 Free. Senior Jackson Carlile and junior Kyle Ponsler finished one-two in the 500 Free as Fishers captured the runnerup title.

In 2022, Carmel started off with their medley relay setting a new state meet record and a NEW National record. They won their eighth straight title with the second highest point total in state history. Zionsville finished second and Fishers third. Michael Schott of Culver Academies won the schools first ever state title by capturing the 200 freestyle. Thereafter Danville's Holden Higbie captured their school's first title in Diving. Will Modglin of Zionsville won two state titles in 100 backstroke the 200 I.M. with the I.M. being a record setting performance. Matthew Klinge of Harrison (West Lafayette) won the 50 freestyle. Kyle Ponsler of Fishers won the 500 freestyle after missing out on a title in the 200 freestyle. Carmel's Aaron Shackell was the 100 butterfly champ. He and his sister, Alex Shackell are the first brother – sister duo to win a title in the same event in the same year in IHSAA history. Carmel won all three relays and Sean Sullivan won the 100 freestyle and Ryan Malicki the 100 breaststroke.



Hobie Billingsley Award




The Hobie Billingsley award represents the most esteemed honor to be bestowed upon a high school diver or coach. Hobie's many contributions to the sport of diving have been recognized at the state, national, and international levels. He began his career as a physical education teacher and high school swimming and diving coach, served as a diving coach at Ohio University and was Indiana University's first diving coach. Hobie was recognized as Diving Coach of the Year seven consecutive seasons from 1964-70. Hobie coached 14 NCAA diving champions during his tenure at IU, 14 indoor diving champions and 23 Olympic divers. He served as the Olympic diving coach in 1968 and 1972, while coaching Austria (1976) and Denmark (1980). Hobie went on to produce 115 National U.S. Diving Champions. Although Billingsley was a master teacher of national and international athletes, he remained true to the developmental aspect of the sport by conducting world renowned diving camps for student athletes and coaches of all ages.

James E. "Doc" Counsilman Award



This award was established to honor Doc's many contributions to the world of swimming. The Counsilman Award recognizes lifetime achievement, and should be considered the highest honor bestowed upon the recipient, as chosen by the Indiana Swimming and Diving Hall of Fame Committee. Doc Counsilman is considered to have been not only the greatest swim coach of all time, but also the greatest coach of any sport ever. His coaching record at Indiana University is unmatched in any sport. While coaching at IU, Doc's teams won six consecutive NCAA Championships (1968-73), and 20 straight Big Ten Titles. He coached the US Olympic swim team to unprecedented victories in 1964 and 1976. In 1968, Doc completed the long revered "The Science of Swimming" which gave the entire world access to his theories and expertise. In essence, Doc played a large role in educating all ages from club, high school, to college, both nationally and internationally. The IU Natatorium, located on the IUPUI campus, was designed by Counsilman in 1982 and is one of the fastest pools in the world. He will be remembered as a scientific genius and a master psychologist. He was the first person to tie scientific research into the coaching profession, and he backed up scientific theories with practical application. His many innovations impacted the sport in such a way that he changed the course of history.

Harry Inskeep Scholarship



Harry (Don) Inskeep was inducted in the inaugural High School Swimming and Diving Hall of Fame class in 2007. He served the IHSAA for 48 years as a swimming and diving official. He worked 50 sectionals, 7 state meets as assistant starter, 5 state meets as referee starter, 22 state meets as stroke and turn judge, and 1 state meet as the diving referee. He has worked 274 IHSAA tournaments, refereed state meets in 5 different decades, and worked in 79 counties. He officiated baseball, basketball, football, track, swimming, and cross country at the high school and college levels.

When he officiated swim meets (or any other sport) he would take the money that he made from officiating and gave that money to a college-bound senior athlete that displayed good sportsmanship and character to help with college expenses and continue sending money to these individuals throughout their college careers.

Mr. Inskeep would send many hand-written letters to athletes, coaches, teachers, and people in the community to say thanks or to congratulate you for special accomplishments. In 1995 Gov. Evan Bayh awarded him the Sagamore of the Wabash, the highest honor the state of Indiana can give to a civilian

Throughout 2006 - 2007 he was instrumental in helping the Indiana Swimming & Diving Hall

of Fame Board of Directors establish the infrastructure of the organization through his fundraising efforts. Upon his passing in November, 2007, the Indiana High School Swimming and Diving Hall of Fame established a scholarship in honor of this role model and humanitarian.
