# History of IHSAA Swimming Championships

Between 1968 and 1974, the Division for Girls' & Women's Sports and the State Girls Athletic Association (G.A.A.) sanctioned the state meets for swimming. The competition comprised of 14 events, and each contestant could participate in up to four events. Teams could enter up to five people in a relay, but only four were allowed to swim. There were no restrictions on the number of participants per team for individual events, and each school could field two relay teams. The competition progressed through sectionals, regionals, and ultimately, the State meet. Four individuals from each sectional qualified for regionals, and two from each region advanced to the State meet.

The inaugural IHSAA Girls' State Swim Meet took place on March 14-15, 1975, at Warren Central. A total of 94 schools participated in the sectionals, and 74 of them advanced to compete in the State Meet.

The 2nd Annual IHSAA State Meet for girls' swimming was held in 1975, but with a significant change in schedule and venue. The competition took place on December 12-13, 1975, on the campus of Ball State University in Muncie, Indiana. Additionally, the number of sectional sites increased to ten.

In 1976, the format of events for the IHSAA Girls' State Swim Meet underwent significant changes. All of the 50-yard events, except for the 50-yard freestyle, were eliminated, and the 400-yard freestyle event was replaced with the 500-yard freestyle event. There were 11 sectional sites, and a total of 121 schools participated in the competition.

In 1978, there was a change to the swim season which resulted in a shortened schedule by almost four weeks, moving the start date from December 13 to November 17. Despite the change, a large number of schools, 147 in total, still participated in the event with 14 sectionals being held. This resulted in a significant representation of athletes with 553 individuals from 89 different schools competing at the state level.

The 9th Annual IHSAA State Meet was relocated to the Indiana University Natatorium on the IUPUI campus in Indianapolis in 1982. The competition involved 163 schools that commenced the event at 15 sectional sites. At the state meet, 571 female athletes from 98 schools participated. The I.U. facility's larger size necessitated a modification in the scoring system from 12 to 16 places, which increased team scores and the number of participants eligible to compete at the state level.

In 1984, modifications were made to the criteria for swimmers and divers to qualify for the state meet due to the increasing number of teams participating. Under the new rules, only the individual sectional champion in each event, as well as any participant who meets or surpasses the state time standard in their respective events during the sectional finals, can proceed to the state meet. The next highest number of competitors required to reach a total of 32 entrants in each event will also advance. Additionally, three divers from each sectional site qualify for the state meet. This represented a change from the previous system where the top two finishers in each event advanced to state.

Heidi Hendricks from Logansport accomplished a remarkable feat in 1987 by becoming the first individual to win eight events in her swimming career across four distinct individual events. Six of her swims were record-breaking performances, which served as a fitting end to her illustrious high school career. Meanwhile, Carmel made history by scoring a record 304 points and clinching the title. Their score was the first to exceed 300 points in the tournament's history.

The swim season in 1990 was further shortened to November 2-3. This year, the latest addition to high school swimming was introduced in the form of the 200 yds. Freestyle Relay. This new event proved to be popular, as it boosted participation and a team's score by up to 40 points at the state level. However, the rules stipulated that no contestant could participate in more than four events, with at least two being relays. A relay itself counted as an event. A contestant could enter three relays and two individual events, but could only participate in two relays and two individual events. Alternatively, a contestant could enter and compete in three relays and one individual event.

The 20th Annual IHSAA State Meet in 1993 was notable for featuring a record-setting 20 swim sectionals, with 206 schools participating in sectional competition. A total of 3,254 female athletes represented these schools, making for an impressive turnout.

In 1995, the first diving regionals were introduced, and they proved to be successful in managing the number of divers advancing to the state level. This helped bring diving in line with swimming in terms of the number of qualifiers for each event.

The Carmel swim team made a significant mark in IHSAA history by winning the 22nd annual State swimming and diving title, marking their 10th consecutive championship. This achievement is unparalleled in any other sport, with no school winning more than nine consecutive titles. Carmel advanced an impressive 20 swimmers to the State meet, with entries in every event except for diving. In the 200 freestyle, 500 freestyle, and 100 backstroke events, they boasted an unprecedented three top-eight finishers. Additionally, all three of their relay teams were crowned State champions.

The 23rd Annual IHSAA State swim meet marked the fourth and most significant change in the girls' swimming season. Held on February 14 and 15 of 1997, the season transitioned from a fall to a winter sport, making it longer and colder. As a result of this change, the 1996 year is missing from this booklet. The IHSAA made this move to offer more girls the opportunity to compete in a winter sport, as previously only basketball and gymnastics were available. With this change, the IHSAA aimed to balance the competition season, with four sports in the fall, three in the winter, and three in the spring.

Carmel continued their historic run of team championships, capturing their 12th state championship and 11th in a row. The Greyhounds hold the longest IHSAA championship streak in any sport. They broke their own record of accumulating the most team points, achieving a new high of 420.5 points. With an unprecedented four top-eight finishes and all three relays winning State championships, Carmel proved their dominance yet again. Additionally, sophomore Michala Kwasny of Fort Wayne Snider and senior Melissa Sugar of Evansville Day were double winners in their individual events. Sugar was also honored with the Mental Attitude award.

The 24th Annual Indiana Girls Swimming and Diving championship was an exceptional State meet in many ways. Firstly, Carmel girls' team won their thirteenth State title, which was also their twelfth title in succession. Their dominance was largely due to taking all three relays and two individual titles. Secondly, there were three double winners: Michala Kwasny, Lacy Boutwell, and Katie Fields. Thirdly, Kwasny (I.M.), Fields (500), and Carlberg (Back) won their events for the third consecutive year. Additionally, three State records were broken, including the 50 freestyle record which stood for ten years and was broken by freshman Lacy Boutwell. The runner-up spot was secured by Center Grove for the first time.

Carmel High School extended its historic streak to fourteen consecutive state titles by winning the 26th Annual State meet, while North Central swim team achieved its first-ever runner-up finish. This year's meet featured some of the closest finishes in the 200 IM, 100 Fly, 100 Free, 200 and 400 Free Relay events. Freshmen swimmers won two championships and clinched five runner-up finishes, indicating a bright future for girls' swimming in the state. Additionally, five senior swimmers won championships, paving the way for five new individual champions next year. Among them, Jenni Anderson from Chesterton was the only junior to defend both her titles in the 100 back and 50 free events. However, the most impressive performance of the night came from senior Laura Swander of Center Grove, who became the first breaststroker to finish under 1:02 with a time of 1:01.98..

Carmel High School maintained their impressive winning streak by clinching their 15th consecutive championship title. However, their domination in the medley relay event came to an end when Columbus North claimed the victory. Leah Retrum of Columbus North contributed to her team's success by winning individual titles in the 200 IM and 500 Free. Carmel's only win came in the final event, where Tenley Bick emerged victorious in the 100 breaststroke. North Central secured two

freestyle relay titles, and Susan Hentschel won the 200 free event, while Sara Gonzo took the diving title. Jenni Anderson of Chesterton continued her three-year dominance in both the 50 free and 100 backstroke, becoming a six-time winner and earning the mental attitude award. The remaining individual champions were Katerine Robinson in the 100 butterfly and Lacey Boutwell, who won her third title in the 100 free. The finals drew a single-day record of 2,518 fans, and the two-day attendance set a new record of 4,470.

Carmel's team slogan "Sweet Sixteen & Never Beaten" rang true as they won their 17th State Championship in the 28 years since the IHSAA started holding girls swimming championships. The meet started and ended with victories for Carmel in the 200 medley and 400 relay events. While Carmel did not have any individual winners, Columbus North's junior Leah Retrum shone as the individual star of the meet, setting meet records in the 500 free and 200 IM. Retrum shared the spotlight with her cousin Kari Retrum, who won the diving event. Two other double winners were Portage senior Kristy Siminiski, who won the 100 and 200 free, and South Dearborn junior Katherine Robinson, who set a meet record in the 100 fly and won the 50 free, bringing her total of state titles to four in three years. The Mental Attitude Award Winner was Kristy Siminiski. Other event winners included North Central in the 200 free relay, Erin Morris from Fort Wayne Snider in the 100 back, and Leslie VanWinkle from Evansville Harrison in the 100 breaststroke.

Carmel High School secured their unprecedented 17th consecutive state championship title by a narrow margin of only 18 points, marking their 18th state title overall. This victory over North Central was the closest finish since their winning streak began. Carmel's 200 medley relay team was the only squad to capture a championship title, while Erin Sparks claimed the individual title in the 100 breaststroke. North Central finished in second place for the fourth consecutive year but earned five state titles, including victories by Susan Hentschel in the 200 and 100 freestyle events and her role as anchor on the winning 200 and 400 freestyle relays. North Central also secured their fifth title in diving thanks to Julie Broms, who set a state-meet record of 477 points, surpassing the oldest record in the meet, held by Franklin's Dana Wiegand in 1982 (473.30 points). Leah Retrum of Columbus North extended her four-year dominance in the 500 free and three-year dominance in the 200 IM, holding the state record in both events. Katherine Robinson of South Dearborn set a record time in the 100 butterfly and also won the 50 free, accumulating six individual state titles in her career along with the Mental Attitude Award.

As the IHSAA marks its centennial year, the girls' swimming tournament celebrates its 30th state finals with Carmel High School clinching an unprecedented 18th consecutive and 19th overall title. Erin Sparks was the star performer for Carmel, taking home four gold medals along with the Mental Attitude Award. With this achievement, Sparks concludes her high school career with a remarkable seven state championships to her name. Meanwhile, Brittany Feldman of Indianapolis Broad Ripple made history by becoming the first girl from Indianapolis Public Schools to win a state title in diving.

Carmel High School continued their historic reign in girls swimming, securing their nineteenth consecutive state championship and twentieth overall with the help of four different coaches over the years. Hamilton Southeastern made history of their own by earning their first-ever state runner-up finish with a total of 200 points, kicking off the finals with a new meet record in the 200 yard medley relay. The diving competition saw Kelci Bryant and Brittany Feldman both break the state record. Freshman Michelle McKeehan from Center Grove took home two individual titles in the 200 yard individual medley and 100 yard breaststroke. Senior Taylor Baughman from Crown Point defended her titles in the 50 and 100 yard freestyle, becoming a four-time individual winner and an eight-time winner including relay swims. Jeffersonville celebrated their first state champion in Ariel Martin, who won the 100 yard backstroke, while Margaret Bird from Yorktown won their first state championship in the 200 yard freestyle. North Central's Christine Shehorn won the mental attitude award and successfully defended her title in the 500 yard freestyle.

Carmel High School continued its two-decade-long winning streak in girls' swimming as they claimed their 20th consecutive state championship, setting the record for the longest title streak in IHSAA sports history. It is also the longest active streak and tied for the 7th longest in any sport nationally. While they started the meet strong by winning the 200 medley relay, Chesterton dominated the latter part of the meet, winning four of the last seven events including two relays. Brittney Feldman of Indianapolis Broad Ripple won the diving competition for the second time in three years and was also awarded the IHSAA Mental Attitude Award. Michelle McKeehan from Center Grove and Maggie Bird from Yorktown both won two individual events, while Christy Grcevich of Chesterton won the 100 butterfly for the second time in three years, and Talor Whitaker claimed her first individual title in the 100 freestyle. Chesterton also won both the 200 and 400 freestyle relays with the help of Lipniskis and Kehe.

Michelle McKeehan of Center Grove achieved a rare feat by winning the 200 IM and the 100 breaststroke for the second consecutive year as a sophomore, putting her in the same league as only three other girls swimmers who accomplished the same feat as freshmen and sophomores: Buffy Horlander of Ben Davis, Debbie Daniel of Anderson, and Lindsay Benko of Elkhart Central. Margaret Bird of Yorktown defended her state title in the 200 freestyle and became the first back-to-back winner in that event since Lindsay Benko's four-year streak from 1991-94. Bird also won the 500 freestyle for her second title of the meet. In a first for the 32-year history of the state finals, a tie for first place occurred in an event as Yorktown's Kelsi Hall and Jeffersonville's Ariel Martin both touched the wall simultaneously in the 50 freestyle. Harrison (WL)'s Connolly claimed the 100 backstroke title.

Carmel continued its dominance by winning its 21st consecutive girls state swim meet, despite facing strong competition. The meet was held at the IUPUI Natatorium, which has been known as the fastest pool in the world for the past 25 years. The highlight of the meet was Center Grove's Michelle McKeehan, who broke future Olympic swimmer Natalie Coughlin's national record in the 200 yard Individual Medley with a time of 1:58:06. McKeehan also set state records in the 100 yard Breaststroke and the Individual Medley. Hamilton Southeastern had a great showing, winning all three relays and finishing as runners-up for the second time in a row. Their 200 Medley Relay team, consisting of Maegan O'Connor, Christina Jacobs, Lindsay Rogers, and Carly Mercer, set a new state record. Talor Whitaker from Chesterton won the 100 and 200 Freestyle events, while Jenny Connolly from Harrison won the 100 Butterfly and 100 Backstroke. Finally, Heritage Christian made their debut, and their diver Audra Egenolf won first place.

The 200 Medley Relay began the meet with a state meet record for Hamilton Southeastern. Throughout the meet, four additional state records were broken, along with a national record. Michelle McKeehan of Center Grove joined Olympians Lindsay Benko and Heidi Hendricks as the only female athletes to win eight individual events. Harrison's Jenny Connolly broke records in both the butterfly and breaststroke events, earning two titles. Carmel claimed their 22nd State Championship, only missing wins in diving and the 500 Free event, which was won by Samantha Partridge. Hamilton Southeastern finished second overall and ended the meet with a victory in the 400 Free Relay. Four Indiana girls swimmers will be competing in the Olympic trials this summer.

Carmel continued its dominance in girls' state swim meets by winning its 23rd consecutive title. The team won eight out of 12 events and set two national records in the 200 Medley and Free Relays. They finished with a state-record of 417 points, which was 200 more than the second-place Hamilton Southeastern. Jessie Hammes was also awarded the Mental Attitude Award. The team aimed to be "LIKE MIKE" Michael Jordan and his famous #23 jersey. The victory left the team with an "UNBELIEVABLE FEELING."

Carmel continued its dominant streak by winning their 24th consecutive state title (25th overall) and more than doubling the score of their closest opponent, Center Grove. Trish Regan of Carmel and Kait Flederbach of Westfield both secured double wins in their individual events. Carmel also won all three relays

In 2011, the Carmel swim team maintained their winning streak with 25 consecutive wins and 26 overall victories. The team also broke a national school record in the 200 medley relay. Rhiannon Sheets, a Carmel swimmer, broke Lindsay Benko's 1994 record by setting a new State Record in the 200 yd. freestyle event. Meanwhile, Mary Beth Dunnichay of Elwood finished her senior year with a new diving state record, surpassing the former record by 40 points.

The Carmel High School Girls continued their winning streak at the 2012 State Championship, making it practically a tradition for them. However, for the first time, the runner-up team was Zionsville High School. Olivia Kabacinski from Chesterton made history as only the 12th three-time winner, claiming victories in both the 50 and 100 freestyle events. Brittany Robinson from Wawasee also made a mark by setting the only state record in the 100 butterfly event.

In 2013, Carmel High School continued its domination in girls' swimming, winning all three relays and setting a national record in the 200 medley relay. Freshman Claire Adams also made her mark by winning two events and setting a new state record in the 100 backstroke. Meanwhile, Veronica Burchill, another freshman from Carmel, won the 100 freestyle and was part of all three winning relay teams. Bethany Galat from Penn High School was a double winner and led her team to a runner-up finish. There were also some surprise winners, such as Brittany Walters from Northridge who won the 500 freestyle from an eighth place seed, and Alex Cleveland from Zionsville who won the 50 freestyle. In addition, Indianapolis Cardinal Ritter won their first state title in diving. This was the 39th annual girls state swim meet and Carmel's streak continued to be the longest active streak in the nation in any boys or girls sport.

Carmel continues to dominate as their winning streak reaches 28, putting them on track to break the national all-sports record. The 2014 state swim meet saw nine state records broken, matching the 1978 record. Carmel claimed six of those records, all of which were their own. Both the 200-yard medley and 400-yard freestyle relay records were national public school records. Junior diver Sarah Bacon successfully defended her title and set a new state record. Bethany Galat from Penn won her fifth state title, breaking the record in both the 200-yard IM and breaststroke by almost half a second. Crown Point placed second for the first time in their girls' swim history.

The Carmel girls swim team continues their unprecedented dominance, winning nine out of 11 events and setting national records in all three relays. They secured their victory with an impressive 266-point lead over second-place Fishers, sending every swimmer from preliminaries to finals. This record-tying 29th consecutive state championship places them alongside Honolulu's Punahou HS Boys Swimming (1958-1986) as the most successful high school sports dynasty in the nation. Carmel set thirteen new records throughout the meet, including the relays. Lillia King of Evansville FJ Reitz won the remaining two swimming events and set a new record in the 100 breaststroke, ultimately winning the Mental Attitude award. Brooke Schultz also set a new record in diving. Lafayette Jefferson became the first state team champion in 40 years to be honored, and the incoming class of 2015 was inducted into the Swimming and Diving Hall of Fame.

The Carmel girls swim team now holds the national record for the longest string of high school state championship wins in any sport. Dozens of former Carmel swimmers came to witness the record they helped to create. Claire Adams of Carmel won two events, two relays, and the Swimming Mental Attitude Award. Her win in the backstroke set a state record and made it four in a row. Adams became the first swimmer in Indiana history to win 16 state titles flawlessly. Her teammate, Veronica Burchill, won the 100yd. butterfly with a record-setting performance and was a member of all three winning relays. Emma Nordin of Carmel was a double individual winner. Hamilton Southeastern and Chesterton battled until the last relay with HSE finishing second by only a half-point difference.

Carmel extended their impressive streak of 31 consecutive state titles at the national level without any doubts from spectators. Chesterton achieved their first-ever runner-up title in girls swimming, while Carmel won all three relay championships. Emma Nordin of Carmel won her third consecutive title in the 500-yard freestyle and her second in the 200-yard freestyle. Sammie Burchill of Carmel broke a decade-old record set by Michelle McKeenan of Center Grove in the 200-yard

individual medley, and placed second in the 100-yard backstroke. Trude Rothrock of Carmel finished as the runner-up in the 200-yard freestyle and won the 100-yard butterfly. Kelly Pash of Carmel emerged as the champion in the 100-yard freestyle. Bloomington South's Grace Haskett was a double winner in the 50-yard freestyle and 100-yard backstroke, while Emily Weiss of Yorktown secured the 100-yard breaststroke title for the second year in a row and set a new state record, surpassing Olympic gold medalist Lilla King's record. Ivy House of Hamilton Heights was victorious in the diving event, and Lauryn Parrish of Fishers received the Mental Attitude Award.

Trude Rothrock and Kelly Pash, both swimmers from Carmel, secured four first-place finishes and two relay championships, helping their team to achieve their 32nd consecutive state championship win (33 in total). Emily Weiss of Yorktown won her third straight title in the 100 breaststroke, setting a new national record in the event. Other individual champions included Julia Wolf from Bloomington South, Kay Foley from Munster, Tessa Wrightson from Zionsville, and Sara Troyer from Northridge. Alex Bader was named the first Mental Attitude winner for Jay County. Northridge achieved their first-ever second-place team finish at the State Championship, and their coach, Hembree, was awarded Coach of the Year.

The Carmel team was so dominant that the combined point totals of the runner-up and third place teams (167.5 & 165) wouldn't have beaten them. Their win streak now stands at 33 in a row (34 total) thanks to their sweep of all three relays and three individual titles. Kelly Pash, a senior at Carmel, capped off her impressive career with four more medals (12 total) and five individual championships. Emily Weiss of Yorktown completed her senior year with four consecutive titles in the 100-yard breaststroke, maintaining her position as the IHSAA state record holder and the fourth-fastest in national high school history. Jackie Brenn of Homestead won the diving event and holds the title of the most accomplished high school diver in IHSAA history with two individual titles and two runner-up finishes to cap off her remarkable high school career.

Carmel continued their dominance by winning all three relays and two individual titles (Lueking in the 200 Free and Berglund in the 100 Back) en route to their 35th State Championship in a row (34 total). Zionsville's Devon Kitchel was the only double winner, claiming titles in the 200IM and 100 Fly. Despite a major youth presence at the meet, only one senior, Elizabeth Broshears from Evansville Reitz Memorial, won an individual title and was named Mental Attitude Winner. Other champions included Paegle from Bloomington South in the 100 Free, Casey from Fishers in diving, and Huff from Noblesville in the 100 Breast. Mary Cate Pruitt repeated as champ in the 500 Free.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this year's state finals were held without spectators for the first time. Carmel once again emerged as champions, and seven of the eight defending state champions successfully defended their titles, tying a state record also achieved in 1980, 1987, and 1993. The Carmel team set a new record by outscoring the second-place finisher, Fishers, by a 279-point margin. Mary Catherine Pruitt maintained her three-year dominance in the 500 free, while Devon Kitchel became the only double-winner of the meet, winning both the 200IM and 100 Fly. Fishers' Morgan Casey won the diving title for the second consecutive year, and Paegle of Bloomington South claimed victory in the 100 Free. Freshman Christianson of Penn won the 50 free. Carmel swept all three relays, and Lueking and Berglund won the 200 free and 100 back, respectively. In a surprise upset, Lieske won the 100 breaststroke from lane 6. Maggie Love of Carmel was named the mental attitude winner, adding to Carmel's impressive list of accomplishments.

As expected, Carmel extended their winning streak in an impressive fashion. The state finals featured the establishment of seven new state records, affirming Indiana's status as the top girls' swimming state in the country. Bloomington South's Kristina Paegle won both the 100 and 200 freestyle events and set new meet records in the process. Zionsville's Devon Kitchel, a three-time winner in the 200 IM, also won the 100 breaststroke. Carmel's freshman standouts, Alex Shackell and Lynsey Bowen, set new records in the 100 butterfly and tied the 2015 record in the 500 freestyle, respectively. Both girls were part of the winning 400 freestyle relay team. Penn's Lilian Christianson

defended her 50 freestyle title and broke the record. Carmel's Berit Berglund won the 100 backstroke for three consecutive years and set a new record. Finally, Carmel's 200 medley relay team set a new meet record. In diving, Mia Prusiecki of Center Grove emerged as the winner, while Northridge girls claimed the 2nd, 3rd, and 6th positions.

The Greyhounds effortlessly maintained their position as the greatest dynasty in high school sports by securing their 37th consecutive win. Carmel triumphed in a state-record 10 out of 12 events, with two of those victories breaking national records - the 200 medley relay and the 200 free relay. Lynsey Bowen set a new state record in the 500 Free, which she won alongside the 200 Free. Alex Shackell also clinched two state record-breaking wins in the 50 Free and 100 Fly. Meanwhile, Molly Sweeney took home the 200 IM with a state record, as well as the 100 Breast. Berit Berglund maintained her four-year reign in the 100 Back, while Meghan Christman was a member of all three relays. Lilian Christianson of Penn set a new record in the 100 Free. Mia Prusiecki of Center Grove won diving for the second time, while Fishers placed second for the third consecutive year.

This was the IHSAA 50<sup>th</sup> Girls State Swim Meet and Carmel girls continued their streak of 38 straight consecutive state championships (total 39 wins) – a feat which is a national record for any school in any sport. Two swimmers from Carmel, junior Alexandra Shackell and sophomore Molly Sweeney each took home four first place medals. Junior Lynsey Bowen from Carmel garnered three. Lilian Christianson 12<sup>th</sup> from Penn was a double winner in the 50 free (record), 100 free and a member of the winning 200yds. Free relay. Amelia Rinehart of Fort Wayne Snider won diving and Avery Stein of Fishers won mental attitude. Emily Logan was the state coach of the year from Greenfield Central.

Carmel HS wins 39<sup>th</sup> straight title and this was the first time Carroll (FW) HS has finished runner-up in the team score. Wawasee HS Julie Mischler sets a new state record in the 100 free and captures the 50 free event too. Carmel won six events, sweeping the three relays to go along with wins from Lynsey Bowen 200 freestyle, Alexandra Shackell 100 fly and freshman Ellie Clark in the 100 back. Shackell, an Olympic gold medalist, finished out her final State meet with 15 State titles which includes a four year dominance in the 100 Fly. Carroll (FW) Jordan Glassley came from behind to win the 200 IM, Fishers sophomore Emily Wolf won the 500 Free and Valparaiso Junior Madeline Moreth claims the title in the 100 Breaststroke. ## Multiple Win Athletes

In the State Championships, there have been multiple athletes who have achieved numerous wins. It's important to note that from 1974 to 1990, swimmers were limited to entering three events, one of which had to be a relay. From 1991 to 1995, swimmers were allowed to enter four events, two of which had to be relays. This means that some athletes were restricted in the number of events they could participate in.

There have been many impressive achievements throughout the years, including 35 double winners, 16 three-time winners, 15 four-time winners, 10 five-time winners, 7 six-time winners, 4 seven-time winners, and an incredible 5 eight-time winners. The names and years of these remarkable athletes are listed below.

It's worth noting that fifteen swimmers dominated in one event for four consecutive years, with two of these swimmers dominating in two events. Additionally, 29 swimmers held a three-year dominance in a particular event, with two of them dominating in two events. Finally, there are nine divers who have won two state championships.

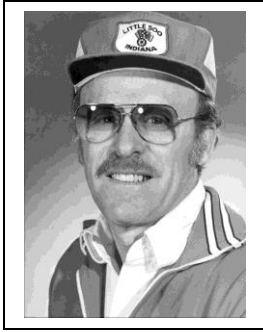

## Hobie Billingsley Award

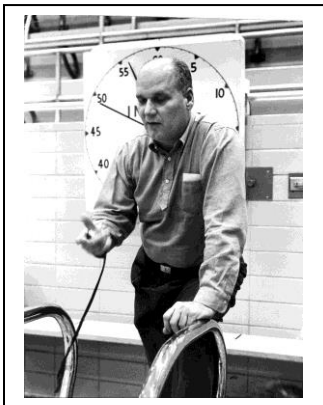


The Hobie Billingsley award represents the most esteemed honor to be bestowed upon a high school diver or coach. Hobie's many contributions to the sport of diving have been recognized at the state, national, and international levels. He began his career as a physical education teacher and high school swimming and diving coach, served as a diving coach at Ohio University and was Indiana University's first diving coach. Hobie was recognized as Diving Coach of the Year seven consecutive seasons from 1964-70. Hobie coached 14 NCAA diving champions during his tenure at IU, 14 indoor diving champions and 23 Olympic divers. He served as the Olympic diving coach in 1968 and 1972, while coaching Austria (1976) and Denmark (1980). Hobie went on to produce 115 National U.S. Diving Champions. Although Billingsley was a master teacher of national and international athletes, he remained true to the developmental aspect of the sport by conducting world renowned diving camps for student athletes and coaches of all ages.

## James E. "Doc" Counsilman Award



This award was established to honor Doc's many contributions to the world of swimming. The Counsilman Award recognizes lifetime achievement, and should be considered the highest honor bestowed upon the recipient, as chosen by the Indiana Swimming and Diving Hall of Fame Committee. Doc Counsilman is considered to have been not only the greatest swim coach of all time, but also the greatest coach of any sport ever. His coaching record at Indiana University is unmatched in any sport. While coaching at IU, Doc's teams won six consecutive NCAA Championships (1968-73), and 20 straight Big Ten Titles. He coached the US Olympic swim team to unprecedented victories in 1964 and 1976. In 1968, Doc completed the long revered "The Science of Swimming" which gave the entire world access to his theories and expertise. In essence, Doc played a large role in educating all ages from club, high school, to college, both nationally and internationally. The IU Natatorium, located on the IUPUI campus, was designed by Counsilman in 1982 and is one of the fastest pools in the world. He will be remembered as a scientific genius and a master psychologist. He was the first person to tie scientific research into the coaching profession, and he backed up scientific theories with practical application. His many innovations impacted the sport in such a way that he changed the course of history.

# Harry Inskeep Scholarship



Harry (Don) Inskeep was inducted in the inaugural High School Swimming and Diving Hall of Fame class in 2007. He served the IHSAA for 48 years as a swimming and diving official. He worked 50 sectionals, 7 state meets as assistant starter, 5 state meets as referee starter, 22 state meets as stroke and turn judge, and 1 state meet as the diving referee. He has worked 274 IHSAA tournaments, refereed state meets in 5 different decades, and worked in 79 counties. He officiated baseball, basketball, football, track, swimming, and cross country at the high school and college levels.

When he officiated swim meets (or any other sport) he would take the money that he made from officiating and gave that money to a college-bound senior athlete that displayed good sportsmanship and character to help with college expenses and continue sending money to these individuals throughout their college careers.

Mr. Inskeep would send many hand-written letters to athletes, coaches, teachers, and people in the community to say thanks or to congratulate you for special accomplishments. In 1995 Gov. Evan Bayh awarded him the Sagamore of the Wabash, the highest honor the state of Indiana can give to a civilian

Throughout 2006 - 2007 he was instrumental in helping the Indiana Swimming & Diving Hall of Fame Board of Directors establish the infrastructure of the organization through his fundraising efforts. Upon his passing in November, 2007, the Indiana High School Swimming and Diving Hall of Fame established a scholarship in honor of this role model and humanitarian.
